2015-2016 School Year

*Beginning with the 2015-2016 School Year:

- All students entering **6th grade** will be required to show proof of one dose of **Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine** given on or after their 11th birthday.
- All students entering **12th grade** will be required to show proof of two **Meningococcal Meningitis vaccines** with the second dose being given on or after their 16th birthday. (Only one dose of Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine is needed for 12th grade of the student's first dose was given at age 16 years or later.)

Is your child ready for school?

If your child is entering Preschool he/she will need _____

- a physical exam
- 3 Polio shots
- 3 Hepatitis B shots
- TB screening
- Proof of age appropriate Pneumococcal vaccination
- Lead screening (**Blood test STRONGLY recommended.**)
- 4 DTaP shots (*Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis*)
- 1 HIB shot (*Meningitis*) (1 or more doses)
- 1 MMR shot (*Measles, Mumps, Rubella*)
- 1 Varicella (*Chicken Pox*) or proof of immunity

Head Start & Early Head Start _____

If your child is going into Head Start, he/she will need to have a physical exam done within six (6) months of starting school, a dental exam within one year, TB skin test results done within the past year or a waiver from physician or Health Department, immunizations, including Hepatitis B, Varicella, and Pneumococcal, date and results of one lead blood test, date and results of a hemoglobin or hematocrit blood test.

If your child is entering Kindergarten he/she will need _____

- a physical exam
- an eye exam
- Polio booster
- proof of 2 MMR shots (*Measles, Mumps, Rubella*) or proof of immunity
- proof of 2 Varicella shots (*Chicken Pox*) or proof of immunity
- Lead screening (**Blood test STRONGLY recommended.**)
- DTaP booster (*Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis*)
- a dental exam

If your child is entering 2nd or 6th Grade he/she will need a dental exam.

If your child is entering 6th or 9th Grade he/she will need _____

- a physical exam
- proof of 2 MMR shots (*Measles, Mumps, Rubella*) or proof of immunity
- proof of 2 Varicella shots (*Chicken Pox*) or proof of immunity
- proof of Hepatitis B completed series is required for **all students grades 6-12**
- Tdap: proof of one dose is required for **all students grades 6-12**

If your child is entering 6th or 12th Grade he/she will need _____

- proof of Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine(s)* (*details on front cover*)

Other immunizations recommended at ages 11-12:

- HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) vaccine for both boys and girls
- Hepatitis A vaccine (if not previously received)
